I have been coordinating with the Miracle League of Minnesota in an effort to build a Miracle League Field in the south metro area. In order to get our fundraising campaign started, I am planning on jumping the St. Paul Ski Club's 47 meter ski jump two times in a tournament on February 2, 2007 at 7:00pm (snow conditions permitting). I am seeking sponsors for my two jumps. I will direct all sponsored money to the Miracle League. I estimate that I will jump between 90 and 120 feet on each jump. You can sponsor me by the foot (estimated to be 180-240 feet total on two jumps), or by a flat amount. No amount is too small! 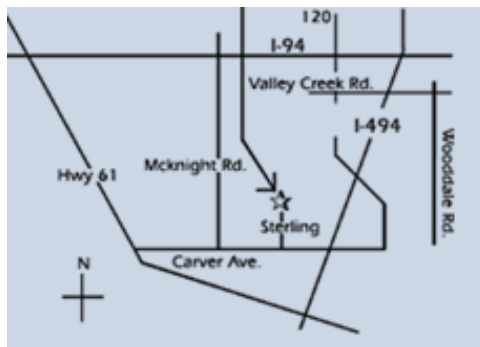
Example “per foot” pledges assuming 200 total feet on two jumps

1 cent per foot = \$2.00

Map & Directions to Jump



The clubhouse and jump complex are located on Sterling Avenue in the south end of Maplewood. The 46 meter jump is visible west of 494 between Lake Road and Hwy 61. THE MAP ABOVE SHOWS CARVER AVENUE INTERSECTING WITH HWY 61 ... THAT IS NO LONGER TRUE, AS IT NOW INTERSECTS A FRONTAGE ROAD. We suggest you print the following instructions and take 'em with you!

If coming from east (Hudson) or west (St Paul) on 94, take Highway 61 southbound to County Hwy 39, Lower Afton Road. Drive about a mile to McKnight, then take a right and follow McKnight until it ends at Carver. Turn left on Carver, drive about a quarter mile, then turn left on Sterling *just before passing UNDER 494 and drive up the hill into our parking lot.*

If coming via 494 from Bloomington or Eagan, you've got to deal with a CLOSED RAMP to HWY 61 North. You must exit Hwy 61 South, go about a mile to Glen Rd, then at the top of the ramp, watch for a left arrow and make what's basically a U-turn onto the northbound ramp. Go north on Hwy 61 several miles to County Hwy 39, Lower Afton Road. Turn right, go about a mile to McKnight, then turn right again, and follow McKnight until it ends at Carver. Turn left on Carver, drive about a quarter mile, then turn left on Sterling just before passing UNDER 494 and then drive up the hill into our parking lot.
