WEST METRO MIRACLE LEAGUE – WHO ARE WE?

The West Metro Miracle League (WMML) is a charitable organization that provides children with cognitive and/or physical challenges an opportunity to play baseball as a team member in an organized and integrated league. The WMML is located and fully integrated in the Bennett Family Ballpark in Minnetonka, MN. Bennett Family Park is the home of eight baseball diamonds that accommodate Tee Ball through Little League and Babe Ruth. Each child playing ball can also be paired with a volunteer “buddy”, if desired, who will give them a little help and encouragement to play the game. These are other ballplayers from the Bennett Family Park system.

As part of the “Miracle at Bennett” overall ballpark improvement project, in the summer of ‘09, we will be playing on the official Subway Restaurants – Harmon Killebrew Field. This is a Miracle League Field sponsored by the Minnesota Twins, Harmon Killebrew and Subway Restaurants. This special baseball field will include a “thick rubber surface to enable all our kids to get around the bases easily.

What are the rules for each player?

- Everyone hits (coach pitch and tees are available for those that want it).
- Everyone gets on base.
- Everyone crosses home plate.
- Everyone wins.
- Everyone can have access to a volunteer buddy (if needed, or they can bring their own).
- Everyone gets a treat ticket after each game to go to the concession stand.
- Everyone gets a medal at the end of the year.
